[Ready for Pensions Auto-Enrolment?](#) - May 2012

We have a problem: Many people are not saving enough to have the income they are likely to want or need in their retirement. The Government is therefore introducing pension auto-enrolment legislation, which comes into force for larger organisations by the end of this year, and for others on a series of dates over the next few years.

[Will This Reduce Claims?](#) - April 2012

Following the Government's election promise to reduce red tape for employers and decrease the burden on the tax payer for funding the employment tribunal system, which currently stands at around £82 million per annum, the first of many changes are due to come into effect from April.

The largest sporting event ever in the UK takes place from 27 July to 12 September. Although there is a three week gap between the Olympics and the Paralympics (which are about one third the size of the main Games), the effects will last throughout this period.
